

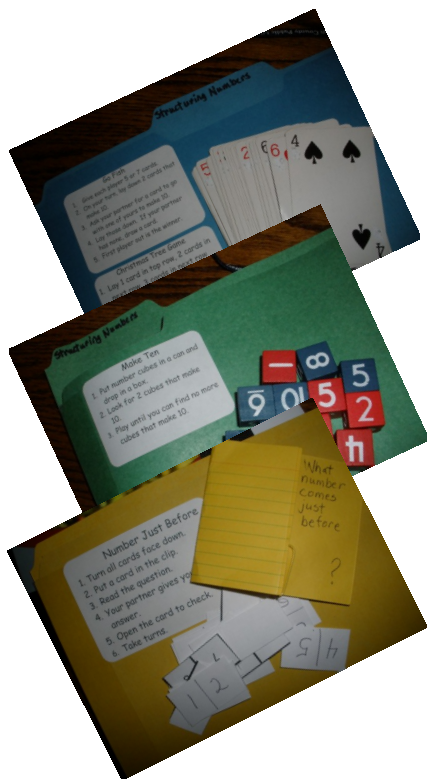


Delving into Differentiation

Experienced mathematics intervention teachers (MITs) who have attended Add+Vantage MR Course 1 and/or the Math Recovery Intervention Specialist course are invited to attend this 2-day workshop during which participants will assemble 90 folders for differentiated numeracy development centers, based on Add+Vantage MR constructs and levels for addition and subtraction, forward and backward number word sequences, numeral identification, structuring, place value, and multiplication and division.
