



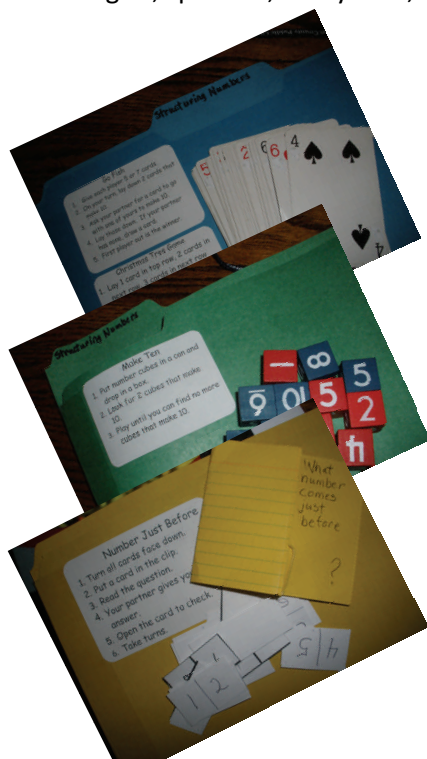

## Delving into Differentiation

Experienced mathematics intervention teachers (MITs) who have attended Add+Vantage MR Course 1 and/or the Math Recovery Intervention Specialist course are invited to attend this 2-day workshop during which participants will assemble 85 folders for differentiated numeracy development centers, based on Add+Vantage MR constructs and levels for addition and subtraction, forward and backward number word sequences, numeral identification, and structuring.

Materials provided for each participant will include:

colored folders; craft sticks & elastic bands; sentence strips; copies and cardware (manipulatives on cardstock); insect counters; frog counters; Unifix cubes; teddy bear counters; dice; dice containers; playing cards; one-color counters; two-color counters; index cards; plates; cups; baggies; spinners; sticky dots, etc...
