The EEMC (Erikson Early Math Collaborative) preschool professional development features content developed by the Erikson Institute, leaders in early childhood education.

Participants Take-Aways:

- An ability to spark children's mathematical learning through developmentally appropriate exploration, discussion and activity
- A firm grasp of foundational mathematics and early childhood development
- High-impact, evidence-based strategies for teaching early mathematics
- Detailed lesson plans using children's literature to support the teaching and learning of early mathematics

Participants should be Kentucky preschool and kindergarten educators and are expected to attend all 8 days of the PD. Coaches and instructional supervisors are eligible to audit the course only if they do so to accompany a participating classroom teacher. Auditing coaches/instructional supervisors are expected to attend all 8 days of the PD.

FREE Registration Includes:

- 8 half-day sessions led by a KCM Regional Coordinator—beginning August of 2014.
- Copies of eight popular children's books to be used with provided lesson plans
- Copy of the Erikson Institute's book Big Ideas of Early Mathematics: What Teachers of Young Children Need to Know

Training involves 8 half-day sessions, beginning August 2014.

Participants: Preschool and kindergarten teachers who want to learn more about early mathematics instruction. Coaches and instructional supervisors may attend along with a participating teacher. This is not a train-the-trainer PD.
