



# KNPI:

## Kentucky Numeracy Project Intensive

This course is built around Add+Vantage Math Recovery and is designed for elementary grades teachers to learn and practice assessments and teaching strategies for advancing students' foundational number knowledge, including addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. Registering for this course also provides Full KCM Membership status to each participant.

### Each participant will receive the following:

- 3 introductory in-person training days, involving live student interviews, dedicated to administration and analyses of diagnostic assessments for beginning numeracy topics in Add + Vantage MR, including:
  - ⇒ Forward and backward number words
  - ⇒ Numeral identification and sequencing numerals
  - ⇒ Structuring number
  - ⇒ Counting objects and addition and subtraction
- 7 follow-up, in-person training days dedicated to:
  - ⇒ Collegial student-centered problem solving
  - ⇒ Review of strategies for analyzing and using diagnostic evidence as an aid in dynamic, data-driven instructional decision making.
  - ⇒ Additional numeracy strands of multiplication and division and tens and ones.
  - ⇒ Effective use of Kentucky Numeracy Project Intervention Guide
- Ongoing, online support meetings
- 2 kits with materials and literature (3 books, handbooks, etc.) for diagnostic assessment and instructional intervention activities.
- Printables from the Kentucky Numeracy Project Intervention Guide
- Free registration for post-conference event at KCM conference
- Opportunity to earn designation of "KCM Intervention Specialist"

**Training involves 10 in-person training days and 3 in-person collegial team meetings, led by Kris Jarboe, KCM Regional Coordinator.**
