



## Kentucky Numeracy Project (KNP) Leadership Institute

During this three-day institute, experienced, highly-trained mathematics intervention teachers (MITs), who choose to attend, will stretch their abilities for helping students build strong numeracy foundations as they hone their leadership skills and strategies for helping other teachers. Work time will include further MIT contributions to the KNP *Intervention Guide* which integrates new Common Core Standards with graduated assessments for learning that allow for targeting and addressing student need with differentiated, instructional trajectories. Work time will also involve enacting effective processes for engaging adults with efficient, meaningful plans to address problems of practice.
