2014 KCM Conference Poster Contest Directions & Rules

- 1. The poster must include the following:
 - o Title
 - Name of Author(s) and Affiliated Organization(s)
 - Abstract (brief summary of objectives, methods, results, and conclusions)
 - Background Information
 - Project Objectives
 - Materials & Methods
 - Results (tables, graphs, charts)
 - o Incorporation of Conference Theme: "Fluency Forward"

NOTE: "Fluency" as defined by the Kentucky Committee for Mathematics Achievement is as follows: "a deep understanding of mathematical concepts, which results in facility to efficiently and accurately access, compare, and apply strategies, knowledge, and skills."

- Conclusions
- Discussion of possible future directions or why project is complete
- 2. Submissions must be made online via the poster submission link found on the 2014 KCM Conference website from December 1, 2013 through February 14, 2014.
- 3. Poster submitters should be registered as a 2014 conference attendee or presentation speaker.
- 4. Posters will be printed by the KCM and will be transported to/displayed at the conference by the KCM staff for your convenience.
- 5. Posters should be designed using Microsoft PowerPoint by creating a slide and setting the page to 3' high and 4' wide (note: one PowerPoint slide=1 poster). Completed PowerPoint slides should then be saved as a .pdf document, and submitted to the poster contest in this format.
- 6. All illustrations and text must be readable from a distance of 3 feet.
- 7. It is solely the responsibility of the person(s) and/or organization(s) submitting a poster to ensure that legal and lawful permission to use of any/all copyrighted material has been properly obtained. KCM and it's affiliates are not responsible for checking that copyrighted material has been used properly.
- 8. Posters will be evaluated by a panel of judges on Monday (3/10/14) afternoon. Poster submitters do not need to be physically present with their posters during the evaluation process.
- 9. Poster contest winners will be announced Tuesday (3/11/14) morning.
